## Instructions for installation and use:

- 1. Unzip yoDraw.zip.
- 2. In the 'company' folder there is a sample logo and a 'company\_config.php' file. You can put your own logo image in that folder. Keep the image size 89px high for best display.
- 3. Open the company\_config.php file in a text editor and change these three lines in bold keeping the quotes around your company information :

```
define ('PDF_COMPANY_TITLE', 'Company title');
define ('PDF_COMPANY_CONTACT', 'Company address, company phone');
define ('PDF_COMPANY_LOGO', 'logo.png'); // the filename_of your logo
```

- 4. Upload all of the folder and files to your web server.
- 5. You'll see a folder named 'drawings'. Change the permissions on that folder to be writeable (777 for many servers). This is where the drawings are stored.
- 6. Go to <a href="http://www.yourserver.com/yoDraw/yoDraw.html">http://www.yourserver.com/yoDraw/yoDraw.html</a> to start drawing!

## To Draw here are a few notes:

- 1. Input width and length of building and click 'draw'.
- 2. Give each building a unique number (use invoice number).
- 3. The date is automatically generated based on today's date. It can be edited as can most text boxes.
- 4. When an object touches a wall, it will want to draw in the dimensions. That's why the lofts and workbench are drawn slightly smaller.
- 5. Delete objects by clicking on them and pressing 'delete' on your keyboard
- 6. Orient the pieces so that the 'handle' of the door/window is facing outside the building. The program uses the orientation of the piece to calculate the dimensions on each wall.
- 7. It may be easier to select objects when the grid is hidden.
- 8. To the right of the 'show grid' button 'Save', draw a line that can be moved and stretched, 'M' will put a text box that can be moved and edited, and a basic 'undo' button.
- 9. To save...
  - a. Click the save button then 'open'. This opens a pdf file in new browser window.
  - b. Save as PDF to your computer or print.
